arrest of their illegal work force."

Napolitano warned in an interview last  
month that the agency would increase  
their auditing of employers internal  
records including the I-9 forms that are  
supposed to be filled out when hiring a  
new employee verifying that the person  
has the right to work. She even suggested  
that ICE would use illegal workers as  
undercover informers to implicate their  
bosses. "What I want to do is deter more  
employers from intentionally and  
knowingly hiring illegal workers," she  
declared.

Employers should heed the clear  
message sent by federal authorities: they  
are going after those who hire immigrants  
lacking proper documentation of their  
right to work. Especially in these tough  
economic times, one should expect this  
type of aggressive workplace enforcement  
of immigration laws to increase with time.


